ITR/R sees potential mutual benefit in connecting research consortia to USAID staff because this may help further USAID’s development efforts and allow USAID to connect consortia to local researchers with whom we already work.</p> <p>To assist research teams, ITR/R can contact relevant USAID experts at Missions or Bureaus who may be able to provide advice or connections to researchers. If these USAID experts are amenable to speaking with research consortia or researchers, ITR/R can make introductions. Note that this is subject to availability of funds from Congress.
